

# Rollands Plains Upper Public School

## Works notification | 12 August 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are upgrading the male and female toilets in Building C, the pupil facilities block, at Rollands Plains Upper Public School.

This work will involve removing bonded asbestos-containing material as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to upgrade the toilets is scheduled to take place outside of school hours between 19 August and 24 September 2025.

Safety measures will be in place during the work including air monitoring, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist before clearance is provided to allow ongoing access.

While the toilets in Building C are being upgraded, students can use temporary toilet facilities in front of Building A.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
