Works notification | 12 February 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During the Summer school holidays a fire damaged the school's computing server in Building G at Rosebank Public School.

We are working to install a new server (in a new location) in a storeroom in Building A. This storeroom has vinyl tiles under the floor coverings that contain asbestos.

Work to remove the vinyl tiles and finish installing the server will take place on Saturday 24 February to Sunday 25 February 2024. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

The tiles are currently undisturbed, and the room is still in use, however, it will be cordoned off before the work starts, and additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place.

Work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The room will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
