School holiday works notification - Summer | February 2024

In December 2023 we sent you a notification about planned Summer holiday works that were happening at the school by Transport for NSW (TfNSW). This work involved working with materials known to contain asbestos as per the school's asbestos register.

This notification is to inform you about other refurbishment works that took place over this holiday period that involved asbestos containing material.

We were replacing carpet in Building D at your school and found vinyl tiles suspected to contain asbestos containing material underneath this flooring. The material was inspected by an independent occupational hygienist and samples were tested. Testing confirmed that the tiles did contain asbestos.

All remediation work was done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The building was inspected by an independent occupational hygienist when the remediation work was finished, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the building carpet replacement work continued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
