## Works notification | 17 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During the upcoming autumn school holiday period, we will be assessing the Administration Building at Ryde Public School to prepare for and understand any future restoration works that may be required.

### Caring for our school's history

The Heritage Stonework Restoration Program helps care for historic school buildings across NSW. As part of our responsibilities under Section 170 of the *Heritage Act 1977*, we work to identify, protect and maintain these important heritage buildings for current and future generations.

### Planned work over the upcoming holidays

On Wednesday 8 April 2026, site conditions and weather permitting, works will commence to determine the current condition of facades including stoneworks, roof and rainwater goods and timber elements including windows.

An elevated work platform will be used to inspect the building. The area will be barricaded and made inaccessible to students. The Out of School Hours (OOSH) and vacation care services which operate out of Building C will operate as normal during the autumn school holidays.

We will provide further updates if restoration work is required.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Together, we're helping ensure Ryde Public School's heritage buildings remain a proud symbol of learning and community for generations to come.
