## Works notification | 22 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We will be removing wall sheeting in 4 classrooms on the upper level of Building C at Ryde Public School.

These walls are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

The current wall sheeting will be replaced with pin boards. This work will take place on Saturday 6 June 2026 and be completed on Sunday 7 June 2026.

The Saturday language class that uses Building C will be moved to a different building on that weekend.

All work involving asbestos containing material will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as fencing, signage, PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
