Following this incident both classrooms were cordoned off to prevent any disruption to learning. The classes were temporarily relocated to the library.

The Year 3/4 classroom that was not vandalised was reopened on Tuesday 6 August 2024.

The carpet and tables in the other room needed to be professionally cleaned. This Year 3/4 class will continue using the library until the end of this week to enable this work to be completed. This class is expected to return to their usual classroom by Monday 12 August 2024.

Work will be done to replace the carpets in the affected Year 3/4 classroom on Saturday 17 August 2024.
