

Shellharbour Public School

Works notification | 1 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers and neighbours,

We will be undertaking excavation, stormwater drainage and landscaping work along the western boundary of Shellharbour Public School during Summer School Holidays.

The stormwater work will include:

- digging of trenches
- installation of subsoil drainage systems
- construction of swale drains to re-direct stormwater and protect vegetation
- removal and replacement of landscaping, pathways and turf.

WaterBoys Plumbing Services has been awarded the tender to be the construction contractor completing this project.

Work is scheduled to begin on Wednesday 17 December 2025 and is expected to be completed on Wednesday 24 December 2025, weather permitting. If inclement weather delays the work, the project will be completed between Monday 5 January 2026 and Monday 12 January 2026.

From Wednesday 17 December 2025 the following activities are expected:

- arrival and movement of construction vehicles
- increased noise
- increased traffic movements.

Construction vehicles will enter the school via the Towns Street entrance and park on the school oval. Traffic control will be used as required for the safety of students, staff and the local community. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers when in place.
