Welcome to our new learning spaces.

Our classes have now moved into the refurbished Inclusive Education building, and students are already loving their new, purpose-built classrooms designed to meet the needs of all learners. Many have shared how much they enjoy the open spaces and new facilities. One student said, “It feels so bright and big, I feel happy coming to school every day”. We are delighted to share that the extension and refurbishment of our Inclusive Education building was completed at the beginning of Term 3, 2025.



The new spaces include purpose-built, open-plan classrooms created to support every learner, breakout areas for small group learning, large accessible toilets and showers, as well as quiet rooms for students who may need a calm environment to support their emotional regulation.

We also recognise the vital role outdoor play has in supporting students’ social, emotional and physical wellbeing. To enhance this, we have upgraded the surrounding outdoor area with new shade sails, a veranda handwashing station to support outdoor art and messy play, and a refreshed environment for play and learning.

It has been wonderful welcoming students into these vibrant new spaces and hearing directly from them how much they enjoy being here. We look forward to seeing the positive impact these facilities will have on learning and wellbeing across our school community.
