Information sessions – 8 May 2025

Thank you to staff, parents and carers who attended the information sessions that took place on 8 May 2025.

An independent hygienist attended to answer questions about results from water quality testing that took place in March 2025. These results are also available on the <u>department's</u> website.

Latest water testing results

Following additional water quality testing at Spring Terrace Public School that we notified the community of on 6 May 2025, we have now received the results.

Following the completion of remediation work, independent testing has returned results in the Building C bubblers that meet the requirements of the <u>Australian Drinking Water Guidelines</u>. The bubblers are being reopened today.

The results for copper and lead in the Building C bubblers are:

- Copper: 70 micrograms per litre (The health guideline for copper is 2000 micrograms per litre).
- Lead: 4 micrograms per litre (The health guideline for lead is 10 micrograms per litre).

Next steps

Plumbing work on the staffroom sink will be completed later this week, with further testing to be undertaken as soon as possible.

We have finalised a full scope of works to replace the water tank and system, and the procurement process to appoint a contractor to undertake this work has now begun.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community is our highest priority.

We will keep the community updated.
