

Spring Terrace Public School

Works notification | 30 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Further to our notification on 3 May regarding results from water quality testing at Spring Terrace Public School, we have been working with the independent occupational hygienist to determine the necessary remediation actions required.

We are planning to fix the school's existing filtration system and disinfect one of the main water tanks.

The independent occupational hygienist will carry out further water quality testing once this work is completed to ensure the water is safe for use.

Precautionary safety measures such as restricting access to the affected taps and the installation of signage warning users not to drink the water will remain in place.

Drinking water can continue to be available for use from the school's unaffected usage points. This is in line with the independent occupational hygienist advice. Bottled water is also being supplied as an alternative for staff and students as needed.

The independent occupational hygienist will provide a clearance certification or further recommendations following the results of this second round of testing.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Department staff will continue working closely with the school and NSW Health to keep you updated on this matter.
