During the school holidays, maintenance works to foyer of the old hall at Warrawong Public School involved working with asbestos containing material in the ceiling lining in Block F.

The material was confirmed as bonded asbestos, which means it was attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure.

Work took place on Friday 7 October 2022. All asbestos containing material was removed outside of school hours and in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

Safety measures and monitoring were in place and the area remained out of bounds to students and staff until the removal work was completed.

This area was remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Testing was completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school has received a clearance certificate and the area is open to students and staff.
