Works notification | 13 March 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

As part of scheduled maintenance, we recently completed drinking water quality testing at Stratford Public School.

This test is conducted twice a year by an independent hygienist as a precautionary measure at schools that use potable tank water.

Water quality test result

The routine test was completed on Thursday 5 March 2026. The results, received on Thursday 12 March 2026, identified the presence of E. Coli in the following locations:

- External bubblers in Building B
- Laundry tap on external wall in Building G

As a safety precaution, access to the affected bubblers and tap have been restricted. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use these outlets. We are coordinating with your school to see if bottled water and hand sanitisers are required for students and staff.

At this time, no other drinking water outlets have been identified as affected.

Necessary works

Licensed and qualified contractors have been requested to attend site as a priority to carry out any necessary works. Once completed, follow-up water testing will be done by our independent hygienist to ensure the water is safe and meets [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).
