

# Stratheden Public School

## Works notification | 18 February 2026

Dear staff,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Stratheden Public School as part of a statewide program of work taking place across NSW.

Findings have detected traces of lead in samples collected from the sink in the male staff toilet in the demountable toilet block.

As a precautionary safety measure, access has been restricted to the tap outlets. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to access the sink.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required as quickly as possible so that affected water outlets are ready for staff to use again.

All work will be carried out by qualified contractors. When work is complete, the independent hygienist will re-test the outlets to ensure the water meets the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
