Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are refurbishing the accessibility bathroom in Building G at Stroud Public School. As part of this work, asbestos containing material within the ceiling eaves will need to be removed.

The area continues to be used as the material is undistributed and out of reach to students and staff. The area will be cordoned off within a construction site and additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place before works start. The area will remain out of bounds until the remediation and associated maintenance is finished.

Work to remove the material will take place between Saturday 26 August and Sunday 27 August 2023.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
