Dear staff and parents/carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Sutton Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Findings have detected some bacteria in samples collected from a number of locations across the school.

Precautionary safety measures have been put in place to support the continuity of learning and teaching at the school. Access has been restricted to the taps and signs have been placed at the outlet to remind students and staff to not drink the water. Bottled water is being supplied as an alternative for staff and students as needed and portable handwashing facilities have been arranged.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required. All work will be carried out by qualified contractors, and we will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water is safe for use. We will provide an update once we have confirmation of the details of this work.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
