Works notification | 10 May 2024



Dear staff, parents/carers,

On 8 May 2024, during an asbestos maintenance inspection at Tabulam Public School, damaged asbestos containing material was discovered in the Electrical Distribution Room in Building F. This is a room that students do not normally enter.

The entrance doorway to the distribution room was locked immediately, with access to students and staff restricted.

Work to remediate the distribution room will take place on Saturday 18 May 2024. Additional safety measures and air monitoring will be put in place before the work starts. The area will remain restricted until the asbestos removal work has been completed.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

When work is complete, the room will be inspected by an independent hygienist and the school will receive a clearance certificate to confirm it has been fully remediated.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
