

# Tenambit Public School

## Works notification | 20 February 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of the department's proactive maintenance, we have removed known asbestos-containing material in several rooms across buildings A, D and E at Tenambit Public School.

The undisturbed material was located within the cupboard doors and ceiling panels of 4 electrical distribution boards.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work to remove the material took place on Wednesday 18 February 2026 and was completed by licensed asbestos contractors. All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours and was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Once the work was finished, the rooms were re-inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they were fully remediated and a clearance certificate was issued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
