Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Two accessibility projects are underway to provide a refurbished drop-off zone and added accessibility features to Tenambit Public School.

The new user-friendly facilities will open for students Day 1 Term 1 2026.

Refurbished drop-off zone

Since our [14 October 2025 update](#), we are pleased to report that tenders have now closed and the contract to upgrade the drop-off zone has been awarded.

Site fencing will be established on Friday 5 December 2025, with works starting from Monday 8 December 2025.

From Monday 8 December 2025, the drop-off zone will temporarily relocate for the remainder of the school year. During this time, parents and carers are asked to use the temporary drop-off zone located on Collison Street.

The new drop-off zone is expected to be finished by Day 1 Term 1 2026 and will feature:

- a large one-way circle for traffic flow
- an electronic access control gate
- remote access for garbage and delivery trucks
- three additional car spots for visitors.

New accessibility features

In addition to the drop-off zone, various enhancements will be undertaken to make the grounds of the school more accessible for students and staff – particularly those requiring extra assistance.

Tenders have now closed and the contract has been awarded for the broader accessibility component of the upgrade. All works are expected to be finished by Day 1 Term 1 2026.

Completed works will include:

- additional entries into the support classroom next to the sports storeroom
- disability thresholds
- access ramps to the support classroom, library and covered outdoor learning area
- additional lighting and easily visible hi-vis markings
- safety bollards
- tactile ground surface indicators in movement areas
- automated library doors
- removing trip hazards and reducing the impact of wet weather.

Construction will start in the summer holiday period. Work hours will be between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.
