## Works notification | 8 November 2024

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

Suspected mould was reported in the Year 3-4 and kindergarten classroom demountables at Terara Public School on Tuesday 29 October 2024.

As a precaution, access to the buildings was restricted from Monday 4 November and students were relocated to alternative learning spaces.

A specialist contractor inspected the areas on the same day and extensive cleaning began on Tuesday 5 November.

### **Year 3-4 demountable**

The Year 3-4 demountable was cleaned throughout Tuesday and Wednesday and reopened on Thursday (7 November).

### **Kindergarten demountable**

The kindergarten demountable was cleaned on Thursday and reopened today (Friday 8 November).

NSW Health advises mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.
