Works notification | 4 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school's general assistant found 2 pieces of bonded asbestos on Tuesday 2 September 2025 on the grounds of Thirroul Public School.

The bonded asbestos was found on the pathway behind the Covered Outdoor Learning Area which is always out of bounds to students.

NSW Health explains the "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The asbestos was removed and the area inspected by an independent hygienist on Tuesday afternoon.

All work involving asbestos-containing material took place outside of school hours.

The area will be added to the school's site-specific asbestos management plan.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was being done. All work was completed by an independent hygienist.

The hygienist confirmed all visible asbestos had been removed and a clearance certificate will be issued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
