Works notification | 21 July 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During routine inspections at Tighes Hill Public School, the Asset Management team identified sections of the wall rendering was chipping off along the northern wall of the school's Hall (Building A).

To rectify the cement in the wall rendering, the wall paint will need to be removed. The paint is suspected to contain lead.

We are following all the advice and protocols of independent hygienists and other experts.

The hall is being safely used at present as the paint is undisturbed.

Testing was conducted by an independent hygienist on Tuesday 18 July 2023 to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If necessary, this area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
