Works notification | 22 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

During repairs to the walkway roof at Toongabbie Public School, the contractor found material suspected to contain bonded asbestos. Work was stopped and an independent hygienist was engaged to collect the material for testing. Testing confirmed that the material contained bonded asbestos.

This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

The area was already inaccessible to students and staff, as the roof was being repaired.

Work to remove asbestos-containing materials will take place on Saturday 30 May 2026.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists before work continues.
