Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

On Friday 29 May 2026, a cracked window was identified in the classroom in Building B at Toronto Public School.

The putty material in this window is known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the School Asbestos Management Plan.

The glass was immediately secured and an independent hygienist was engaged to provide advice. The putty material is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

Work to remove the asbestos-containing material and replace the glass will take place on Saturday 13 June 2026.

All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws. All work will be completed by experienced contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
