As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades.

Trundle Central School facilities upgrade

As part of this investment, Trundle Central will receive a share of \$4.2 million funding to upgrade teaching and learning facilities in Building F.

This includes:


- · upgrading the school's science lab, preparation room and storeroom
- · replacing and repositioning work benches in the science lab
- · upgrading gas and electrical lines
- · replacing vinyl floor coverings
- painting the science lab.

Construction is planned to begin in late April, following a tender process, with upgrades completed by Term 3 2025.
