Tumbulgum Public School Works notification | 10 August 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are demolishing Building C at Tumbulgum Public School. In preparation of these works, asbestos containing material located in several walls, the ceiling cavity and eaves will need to be removed.

We are also repairing flood damage to the administration building and two classrooms in Building A and student toilets in Building B. This work will involve working with asbestos containing material in the wall sheets.

Buildings A, B, and C are currently cordoned off and within a construction site and separated by hoarding and a fence. Additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place before works start.

Work to remove the material will take place on Saturday 26 August and Saturday 2 September 2023.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the contractors will receive a clearance certificate before the demolition of Building C and the remediation and associated maintenance works to Buildings A and B can progress.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
