Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we are removing a tree from the grounds of Turramurra North Public School.

Following the department's Annual Tree Safety inspection, a tree with potential safety issues was identified on the school playground near buildings A and D. This tree is in the centre of the school near the student bench seats. An independent arborist was then engaged to provide an aerial report on this tree.

The result of these inspections and report recommended the removal of a *Eucalyptus resinifera* tree, commonly known as a *Red Mahogany* tree.

To avoid disruptions to teaching and learning, a qualified arborist will remove the tree in 2 stages. This work is planned to be completed over 2 coming Saturdays: 22 March and 29 March 2025.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
