Works notification | 5 February 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Over the Summer school holidays we replaced flooring in 3 rooms in Building G at Ulladulla Public School. During this work, vinyl tiles with suspected asbestos containing material were found underneath the floor covering.

The tiles were inspected by an independent hygienist and sent away for testing. Testing confirmed the tiles did contain asbestos.

Work to remove the vinyl tiles started on the 15 January 2024.

Work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area was inspected after the remediation work was finished and the school received a clearance certificate before the remainder of the floor replacement continued.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
