

Unanderra Public School

Community Update

3 November 2022

Dear school community,

As you are aware, Unanderra Public School was non operational on Tuesday 1 November following a plumbing issue, which affected a number of classrooms.

School staff identified the leak on Tuesday morning and immediately turned off the water mains to limit any further impact and water use. School Infrastructure NSW engaged a plumber who fixed the original problem. An electrician also attended to make the school safe and the Department's IT team was onsite to assess fix any faults.

We can confirm that 6 classrooms have been impacted across 2 levels, including the Practical Activities Area (PAA). We have done an initial assessment of damage and work is underway to clear and dry the water in these rooms. Unfortunately, one ceiling has been badly damaged making it unsafe for students and staff to use that area.

Our experienced asset management team will work with the Health and Safety team to determine whether any of the impacted rooms can be safely reopened to students. The team will make essential repairs and start the insurance claim process. We will keep the school and community updated with progress.

Minimising impacts to teaching and learning

Our priority is always to ensure that students can continue to receive face to face learning in a safe and comfortable environment.

The Department is working with Mrs Anissa Rajendra, Principal, Unanderra Public School to make alternative arrangements for impacted classes onsite.

We thank parents, students and staff for their patience and understanding during this temporary change.
