Works notification | 7 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are pleased to share that we are completing some upgrades to the staffroom and the classroom on the west side of Building 1 at Urunga Public School.

These areas have been used by the Outside Of School Hours (OOSH) service for over 5 years. With the recent departure of the OOSH service, the school will now expand its learning and teaching into these spaces.

To improve the condition of the rooms, particularly the wall linings, we will be replacing the existing wall linings with new, impact-resistant plasterboard. The current lining is known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed in the school's asbestos management plan.

NSW Health advises that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged."

Removal and replacement of the wall linings will take place by the end of November, outside of school hours and will be completed by a licensed asbestos removalist with an independent hygienist onsite.

All work is being done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures are in place while work is being done.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
