## Works notification | 14 May 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

As part of our proactive maintenance schedule, we are replacing the floor coverings in the staff toilets in Building C, at Wentworth Public School.

This area is known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the School's Asbestos Management Plan.

Asbestos was used widely in Australian building materials before 1990. We manage the presence of asbestos in NSW public schools by maintaining an Asbestos Management Plan for each school and engaging independent hygienists for expert advice.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours between 8 am to 5 pm on Saturday 30 May 2026, with safety measures such as PPE and air monitoring in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will take place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
