

# Windellama Public School

## Works notification | 4 December 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our regular maintenance, we will be removing the toilet demountable from the eastern side of Windellama Public School.

During the removal, there will be tradespeople and large vehicles on site. They will access the school grounds through the entrance gates on Windellama Road with traffic management in place.

Due to the age and condition of the demountable and the known presence of bonded asbestos as per the school's asbestos management plan, on-site controlled demolition was determined to be the safest and most practical solution for removal. A hygienist will be present throughout the demolition and removal process. This will take place between Saturday 6 December 2025 to Sunday 7 December 2025 between the hours of 8 am to 4 pm.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
