Fencing and CCTV works notification | 4 August 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Following our notification on [18 February 2025](#), we wish to update you on the new boundary fence and Closed-Circuit TV (CCTV) camera at Woolgoolga Public School.

Work to install the fence and CCTV camera will take place from Monday 18 August 2025 and is expected to be finished within 8 weeks, depending on weather and site conditions.

Working hours are from 7 am to 5 pm Mondays to Fridays, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will be done on Sundays or public holidays.

Work involves:

- Removing the existing fence.
- Trimming and removing various trees and shrubs.
- Installing a black 2.1 metre tubular steel fence around the perimeter of the school.
- Installing 6 manual pedestrian gates and 6 manual vehicle gates.
- Installing 1 electronic access controlled (EAC) gate on Scarborough Street, near the Short Street intersection. This gate will have a CCTV camera installed.

Council permits have been granted for the tree pruning and removal. Many of the trees scheduled for removal are non-native or weed species. The school will replant several shrubs in a more suitable location.

For the safety of the contractors, please secure your pets and keep them away from the work area during the scheduled work times.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
