

Woonona Public School

Works notification | 11 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are replacing the carpet at Woonona Public School in 4 classrooms in Building 6. As part of this work, asbestos containing material within vinyl tiles underneath the existing carpet will need to be removed.

The rooms are being safely used at present as the vinyl tiles are undisturbed and under the carpet.

The classrooms will be cordoned off before the work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place.

Work to remove the vinyl tiles will take place on Saturday 20 May 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The classrooms will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before they are reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
