

# Wyee Public School

## Works notification | 17 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During a routine inspection on Friday 10 March 2023 at Wyee Public School, asbestos containing material was found in old vinyl tiles in a storeroom in Building D and in the exterior wall linings in the eastern side of Building C. Both the vinyl tiles and the wall linings are in the school's asbestos register.

As a precaution and following the advice of hygienists, both areas have been made safe until the materials can be removed. The hygienist is also undertaking air quality monitoring at the school. All air monitoring conducted to date continues to return results below the minimum detection limit (i.e. <0.01fibres/mL).

We will keep the community updated and inform you of the date of remediation works when this is confirmed.

All works involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before works start.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Both areas will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
