Works notification | 19 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

In preparation for painting in Building B, lead-based paint on the internal and external walls of the Special Programs Room and fireplace in Building B will be removed.

Building B is currently cordoned off as a construction site.

The lead-based paint will be removed on Saturday 20 May 2023. All work involving hazardous materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring put in place before the work starts.

An independent occupational hygienist has provided School Infrastructure NSW with a methodology for its controlled and safe removal. All work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before painting works continue.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
