School holiday works notification – Winter | 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the winter break

We will be working at Wyong Public School during the Winter School Holidays – from Tuesday 8 July with work potentially continuing through to early Term 3, depending on weather conditions.

During this period, as part of planned maintenance we will be concreting the grounds on the north-eastern edge of the school. This area will be fenced off within a construction zone.

There may be some construction noise as there will be heavy machinery, including concrete pumps, concrete trucks, and delivery vehicles accessing the school. Some disruption can be expected throughout the construction period. We apologise for any inconvenience.

There will also be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements in nearby streets during the works. Vehicles will access the construction site via the designated entrance on Cedar Close and will take up to 4 street parking spaces along this street.

A traffic management plan will be in place along Cedar Close to ensure the safe movement of vehicles and machinery.

There will be no changes to the outside of school hours (OOSH) vacation care service which will be running as usual. Vacation care drop-off zones and staff car parking at the school will not be affected.

Contractors will have noise and dust mitigation measures in place and will monitor levels throughout the construction period. Construction is due to be completed by Friday 25 July 2025.

Work hours

Work hours are between **7am and 12pm Monday to Friday with no work permitted on weekends or public holidays**, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority and local council guidelines.
