

Yanderra Public School

Works notification | 30 June 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

As we advised on 13 June, further water quality testing has been conducted at Yanderra Public School.

We have now received the results which confirm the school's drinking water meets all health requirements for the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines.

The independent occupational hygienist has advised that all samples taken from drinking outlets achieved satisfactory results and has provided the school with a clearance certificate for normal drinking arrangements to resume.

Regular inspections and testing of the school's water supply will continue to be carried out in the future as part of School Infrastructure NSW's maintenance program.

During retesting, an additional sample was taken from the external tap on Tank 1 on the south side of Block B, which is not part of the school's drinking water supply. Results detected some lead above acceptable levels from the unfiltered sample. Access to this tap will continue to be restricted for grounds maintenance purposes only.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
