

Croppa Creek Public School

Works notification | 11 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Croppa Creek Public School as part of planned maintenance.

Findings have detected some lead above acceptable levels from an external tap on the western side of Block C. All other samples taken at the school have met the necessary health requirements as per the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines.

Access to the tap on the western side of Block C has been restricted in line with the independent occupational hygienist advice. Bottled water is available to the school.

School Infrastructure NSW will now work with the independent occupational hygienist and the school to undertake any remediation work required. All work will be carried out by qualified contractors and School Infrastructure NSW will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water is safe for use.

The health and safety of students and staff is the priority for the school and the NSW Department of Education. Department staff will continue working closely with NSW Health and the school leadership, to keep you updated on this matter.
