

# Woronora River Public School

Works notification | 7 March 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Due to recent storms, upcoming maintenance works to repair damaged storm water pipes at Woronora River Public School will involve working with asbestos containing material in grounds on the school oval.

Work to remove the material will take place on Saturday 11 March 2023. All asbestos containing material will be removed outside of school hours and in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

The area will be cordoned off and separated by fencing and hoarding. Further safety measures such as air monitoring will be implemented before works start and the area will remain out of bounds to students and staff until the removal and associated maintenance work is finished.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff. The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the oval is reopened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
