School holiday works notification – Autumn | 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers, and neighbours,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the Autumn School Holidays

We will be working at your school during the Autumn School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 11 April up to May 2025.

We are pleased to announce that we are upgrading the student toilets in Building H at Woronora River Public School.

This includes new floor tiles, toilets, sinks, lights, partitions, hand dryers, windows, fans, and mirrors.

A temporary toilet block for students will be installed in the staff carpark and staff will park on the surrounding streets for the duration of the project.

Removal of hazardous materials

Part of this project involves removing the ceiling linings. The ceiling linings are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

Once the ceiling linings have been removed, an independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate and the remaining work will continue.

Construction timeframe

Work will start during the Autumn School Holidays and is scheduled to finish in May 2025.

Asbestos removal and demolition work will take place during the Autumn School Holidays when no students or staff are on site.

Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday in accordance with NSW Environment Protection Authority construction times.

Temporary construction fencing will be installed around the work site. These works will not impact school operations.

Contractors and work vehicles will access the school via the main vehicle access gate on Prices Circuit. Work vehicles will park onsite in the school carpark.

Please be aware there will be an increase in noise during demolition works. We will make every effort to minimise noise where possible.



All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.
