Works notification | 24 February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Work to upgrade the student toilet facilities in Building B at Warragamba Public School will begin on 1 March 2025.

Toilet upgrade work will include:

- replacing floor and wall tiles
- installing new sanitary fixtures, including concealed cisterns, toilets/troughs, tapware, sinks and soap dispensers.
- replacing cubicle partition walls
- re-painting.

Work is expected to be completed by Day 1 Term 2.

Students will have access to alternate toilet facilities in Building K while work is carried out.

Asbestos removal

Work will begin with the removal of asbestos material, known to be present in the cubicle partitions as listed on the school's asbestos register, which are currently undamaged and in good condition.

Asbestos removal work will take place outside of school hours on Saturday 1 March, with safety measures in place including restricted access and air-monitoring.

NSW Health explains that living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before upgrade work continues.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
