Investing in our schools

The \$284.3 million <u>Australian Government Schools Upgrade Fund</u> is delivering grants to improve school facilities across the country. These grants are designed to help schools and their students get back on track after disruptions caused by COVID-19. Public Schools in NSW have a \$68 million share of the fund for infrastructure projects and facility improvements.

Project overview

We are delighted to announce that we will be building a new hall at Wiripaang Public School. The new school hall will be located between the existing shade structure, canteen and library.

The hall will provide the school community with a designated space for assemblies, concerts and other events, protected from the weather.

Master planning has finished, and designers have been engaged to develop conceptual drawings ahead of the project being tendered.

Next steps

The project will go to tender in May 2025 with construction expected to start mid 2025.

Proposed design features include:

- school stage and audience allocation
- student toilets
- accessible toilet.

To ensure the safety of students and staff, fencing will be installed around the construction area before works start.
