Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of our planned maintenance work, we are replacing flooring in several classrooms in buildings B and D at Wiripaang Public School.

Removal of vinyl tiles

On Saturday 21 June 2025, we will remove vinyl tiles under the carpet in these rooms. These tiles contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register. The tiles are undisturbed and in good condition.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

While the tiles are being removed, there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

Following the removal and replacement works an independent hygienist will inspect the area and provide clearance to continue using the rooms.

All work involving asbestos-containing material will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Update on the hall

The contract for the new hall is out for tender, with construction expected to start later this year.

We will keep the community updated.
