Pymble Public School Works notification | 16 May 2024



Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are removing 2 demountables at Pymble Public School and transporting them to a storage facility on Wednesday, 22 May 2024.

A crane will be used to move the demountables. This will impact traffic on Rushall Street, which will be closed for at least part of the day.

These demountables have undisturbed asbestos, which is recorded in the school's asbestos register.

The contractor, ProGroup, will place a precautionary asbestos warning sign on each demountable as a transportation requirement.

The work is being done under the SafeWork NSW conditions for releasing a building from a school site, which requires a sticker to be attached notifying that the building being transported contains asbestos.

There is no asbestos removal work being done on the buildings.

Our highest priority is the health, safety and wellbeing of the school and local community.
