

Bald Face Public School

Works notification | 3 June 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

An independent hygienist recently completed scheduled testing and an inspection of Bald Face Public School.

Test results provided by the hygienist found elevated levels of mould in the library. The hygienist advised the elevated levels were linked to the age and condition of some library books.

As cleaning the affected books would not have solved the problem, the most affected books have been removed and disposed of. These books will be replaced over the next few weeks.

As a precaution, access to the library was restricted until an environmental clean could be completed on Monday 1 June 2026. Following the advice of the independent hygienist, the library was reopened on Tuesday 2 June 2026.

All work involving mould took place outside of school hours with appropriate safety measures in place.

NSW Health advises that mould spores are present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and mould is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.
