

Turrumurra Public School

Works notification | 20 July 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

During routine inspections at Turrumurra Public School, several bags containing pieces of fibro assumed to contain asbestos material were found in the subfloor of Building G. The building's subfloor area is inaccessible to students and staff.

As an added precaution, the subfloor access door has been locked until the bags are removed.

Work to remove the bags will take place on Saturday 22 July 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The subfloor of Building G will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened to the General Assistant.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
