Works notification | 9 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Thursday 5 March 2026 a member of staff reported a mouldy smell in the maths storage room attached to the computer lab in Building G at Wattle Grove Public School

The storeroom and attached computer lab were immediately closed and locked to students and staff. Learning was relocated to another classroom on site to continue learning.

An independent hygienist advised the rooms required an environmental clean.

Contractors were engaged to complete an environmental clean of the storage room on Friday 6 March 2026 and this has been completed over the weekend of Saturday 7 March 2026 and Sunday 8 March 2026.

The classrooms and storeroom will reopen once the independent hygienist returns to inspect the work, complete testing to confirm the mould has been treated and confirms they can be used for usual school activities.

All work involving mould took place with appropriate safety measures in place.

NSW Health advises that mould is present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also includes mushrooms and yeast.
