

# Mount St Thomas Public School

## Works notification | 2 September 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will be converting the old toilet area in Building F at Mount St Thomas Public School into an accessible toilet. This work is taking place as part of integration works ahead of Term 4 and began yesterday (Monday 1 September 2025).

During this work, we will be removing wall and floor linings known to contain bonded asbestos as per the school's asbestos register.

All work involving asbestos-containing material will take place on the weekend of Saturday 6 September and Sunday 7 September 2025.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

It is expected that the accessible toilet will be finished by Friday 10 October 2025.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
