Works notification | 5 February 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

The NSW Department of Education is committed to working with schools across NSW to deliver new and upgraded school facilities.

We are upgrading a shower room in Building D at Mount St Thomas Public School. This will involve removing wall lining and vinyl tiles that are known to contain asbestos as per the school's asbestos register.

Work will be taking place on Saturday 17 February 2024. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours.

The room is locked and remains inaccessible, and additional safety measures and monitoring will be put in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The room will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
