Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are replacing the flooring at Mount St Thomas Public School. As part of this work, asbestos containing material in the wall and within the vinyl tiles will need to be removed from a storeroom in Building A.

The storeroom will be cordoned off before the work starts, and safety measures and monitoring put in place. It will remain cordoned off until the remediation and associated maintenance work is finished.

Work to remove vinyl tiles will take place after school hours between Saturday 20 May and Sunday 28 May 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The storeroom will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the school will receive a clearance certificate before it is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
